### Longstone Moor Farm – Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2020

North Derbyshire Dispersal sees flying trade.

The combined sale on behalf of Miss Linda Wood at Longstone Moor Farm together with items from Richard Setchfield of Staveley saw an excellent crowd of bidders with purchasers from Lincolnshire, North Wales and all the surrounding areas.

Some of the stars of the show included a superb Land Rover 90 (December 2012) together with JCB Telehandlers and a Kawasaki Mule Pro DX.

Within the smaller items - a Mini Anvil at £130, Vink Calving Aid at £130, ex London station old wooden Dray £340.

The in situ Trister bin achieved an excellent £2,320. In the outside sundries Horned Sheep Rings to £76 each together with Cattle Feed Rings at £105 and an excellent galvanised Cattle Crush at £1,100 together with Sheep Creeps at £235. The Bateman Lamb Weigher was in excellent order and achieved £510.

Within the machinery from Linda Wood the Fraser Tipping Trailer sold at £1,180 with the Fraser Flat Trailer at £1,920.

A superb Single Axle Ifor Williams P8G Sheep Trailer achieved an excellent £1,600 with the Ifor Williams 12ft Twin Axle Livestock Trailer at a superb £4,020.

The Loader Tractor on the farm was a Ford 6410 4-wheel drive on a G Plate which achieved £7,650.

The Kawasaki Pro DX Mule together with Land Rover saw spirited bidding and attracted much interest with the Mule eventually selling at £7,400 and the 2010 Land Rover with 83,000 miles achieving an impressive £16,000.

As detailed above there was a special entry from Richard Setchfield who has recently closed the Staveley branch with the branch Ford 4-wheel drive Ranger (07) reaching £2,950. A JCB 526-56 (10 Plate) for £15,900. JCB 526S at £12,050 and a 16ft Ifor Williams Flat Trailer (no ramps) at £1,800.

The superb Henton 10 Ton Twin Axle Flat Trailer (shop soiled but totally unused) achieved an excellent £4,650.

Some excellent sundry vendor items achieved good prices including a Siloking Single Axle Diet Feeder at £8,100. A set of stocks 38 inch dual wheels (no clamps) at £1,000 and a Land Rover 90 Truck Cab (52 Plate) at £7,500.
