The Special Produce Auction has been arranged by Joint Auctioneers Bagshaws and Fox Bennett to facilitate the open market sale of all produce situated on three farms in Nottinghamshire and Leicestershire.

Many locals will know of the scheduled sales at Hill Farm, Teversal, Ratby Grange, Markfield together with Ramsdale Farm, Sapcote which had auctions cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions.

This catalogue gives all information and auction sale details for the onsite auctions which will take place on Thursday 10th December with all viewing to be undertaken on sale day.

Purchasers note there are two auction sale sites and any purchaser wishing to view at Ramsdale Farm, Sapcote, Leicestershire must preview all produce on that holding and arrive at Ratby Grange Farm prior to the auction commencing at 2:30pm.

There will be no site sale at Ramsdale Farm as all the produce at that location will be sold at Ratby Grange.

Situation

Hill Farm has excellent national road network access via the M1 from Junction 28 and Junction 29.

The farm lies approximately two thirds of a mile from the centre of Teversal Village toward Pleasley.

From the B6017 between Tibshelf and Stanton Hill turn by the Canarvon Arms, go behind the public house into Pleasley Road and travel half a mile up the hill under the railway bridge into the centre of the village. Take the Pleasley Road in the centre of the village and after two thirds of a mile Hill Farm lies on the right (past the white cottage).

From the M1 and Junction 28, pick up the A38 North towards Mansfield and Sutton in Ashfield. Travel past Sutton in Ashfield on the bypass and arrive at the Kings Mill Hospital crossroads. Pick up the A617 towards Chesterfield and at the top Skegby traffic lights go straight over towards Chesterfield and Mansfield. After half a mile turn left onto the A617 for Pleasley and after approximately 40 yard turn left into Penniment Lane. Continue down Penniment Lane and onto Top Road and after one and half miles at the bottom of the hill turn left sign posted for Teversal. Continue up New Bound Lane and at the severe bend turn left with Hill Farm lying on the left after a third of a mile.

Purchasers beware there are railway bridges on both access routes to the farm and care must be taken at all times. (13'9 and 14'6)

Situation

Ramsdale Farm is situated on the B4114 between Narborough and Sharnford. There is good concrete road access and yard areas at the farm. From the M69 junction 2 Westbound from Leicester and M1 leave the M69 and take the B4669 to Sapcote. Continue through the village and after 2 1/3 miles turn right onto the B4114. Ramsdale Farm is just over ½ a mile on the left adjoining the main road.

From the M69 Junction 1 for Coventry and the M6 (where the A5 crosses). Pick up the A5 towards Lutterworth and Milton Keynes and after 1.8 miles turn left towards Sharnford onto the B4114. Continue through Sharnford village for a further 1½ miles with Ramsdale Farm lying on the right directly off the B4114.
