A busy Tuesday holding the monthly Pedigree Dairy Sale which saw Pedigree heifers top at £2280 and cows to £1900, with commercial heifers up to £2400.

Hogget's even more money this Tuesday with averages up again by 5p/kg and £3 per head! Leading prices of 338p/kg and £152.81 per head. Cull ewes were a strong demand also averaging at £86/head.

More Barren cattle about this week, and an excellent trade selling to 146p/kg for black & whites, and average of 116.34p/kg or £776.95/head. Clean cattle also in good demand up to 218p/kg.

A bumper entry of pigs and trade a little less on the week, with heavy quality pigs up to 129p/kg and bacon pigs at 126p/kg.

Better numbers of calves forward and a mixed quality entry forward, however leading price of £370 for a Limousin bull and Blue heifers to £320.
