Barren cows were a strong trade once again, selling up to 167p/kg for Shorthorns, and clean to 235p/kg for a Limousin heifer.

The sheep section continues to be on a solid enquiry with hogg numbers slowly drying up, trade peaked at 355p/kg and £179.28, with more Spring lambs forward selling up to 378p/kg or £145.93 per head. Culls ewes are in strong demand selling to £165/head.

Dairies sold up to £1930 for heifers from D & W Davenport, who sold others at £1820 and £1750. Don't forget next week is Pedigree Sale!

Calves continue to sell at a pace, with buyers galore for all types. Bulls calves topped at £445 and heifers to £305.
