Finally some sunshine with many farmers in the harvest and making the most of the weather over the Bank Holiday weekend.

Spring lambs are a solid trade, with quality selling extremely well up to 382p/kg and £162.92p/head with the whole entry averaging £130/head. Ewes were a exceptional price with a small entry forward with prices reaching £168 and £162.

Barrens sold on a strong trade up to 176p/kg for Holsteins, with clean cattle topping at 243p/kg for a Limousin heifer.

Demand for calves improves week on week, with more about this week, topping at £444 for Simmental bulls and Blue heifers to £342.

A shortage of dairies, making room for the dispersal next Tuesday.

Pigs were in good demand once again with bacon pigs to 172p/kg.
