The sale on behalf of the Smith family at Lower Castle Hayes Farm, Needwood saw a very large crowd with over 650 lots numbered and the star of the show being a Case 150 Puma 50K tractor on a 67' Plate at over £57,000.

The stars in the tractor line up were the Case 110 Maxxum in spite of having over 12,300 hours on the close and a 12' Plate this achieved £20,800 with the prime mover for the farm Case 150 Puma 4WD c/w Front Linkage (67' Plate-1,351 hours) at £57,200.

Yet again Telehandlers were the talk of the day with the farms Manitou MLT-735 (14' Plate-7,700 Hours) at £28,500 and an older T' Plate Manitou 527 (massive 19,000 hours) at a resounding £10,400.

The very well-kept Honda TRX 500 Quad Bike (nearly 7 years old but with only 575 work hours on the clock) achieved an excellent £7,000 to a local purchaser.
