There was a solid trade from start to finish with customers operating at all price points and a very wide range of prices. It has clearly been a punishing season and many consignments comprised lambs smaller than normal for the time of year as a result of the drought. The best tuppings lambs were much sought after with Mules in the £130 - £160 bracket. At the other end of the spectrum very small running lambs were in the £40 - £50 bracket with the stronger running lambs £80 - £100. The resulting average at £94.30 was more an indication of the cross section of lambs on offer than a figure for statistical use.
