Oliver reported a similar story in the finished ring with finished cattle following their recent run of form with steers to 330p/kg and heifers 319p/kg with numerous grosses of over £2000.

A similar story with the OTM's with trade reported as even dearer than last week with the best to 290p/kg and an overall average of 194.03p/kg.

Finished hoggs little changed on last week averaging 241p/kg and ewes similar again with best continentals to £163.

Calves light on numbers but those forward rewarded with a good trade to a top of £380.
