FOREWORD - S WEBSTER

The genuine dispersal sale of the commercial herd the property of the Webster Family arises as a result of a change in stocking at Gorsty Fields as it now returns to dairy production in the near future.

This impressive herd of Limousin X and Simmental X cows has grown over a number of years with homebred heifers retained to enter the suckler herd.

The cows calve from end January until March and the Limousin and Simmental Bulls went back to the cows in mid April for calving 20th January 2026 onwards. They have all been scanned and results are available on sale day. The herd is strong with large good shaped cows and well bred steer and heifer calves at foot.

All cows were BVD vaccinated 20.07.2024

All cows and calves received Cydectin Wormer on 28.06.2025

All cattle will have received IBR and BVD vaccinations prior to sale.

All cattle had a fly strike application on 28.06.2025

All cows and calves will receive their second Blue Tongue Vaccination prior to the sale.

All breeding cows received a trace element bolus on 27.05 2025 giving 8 month cover.

All calves received trace element/minerals at birth.

The 11 incalf heifers were pelvic measured by LLM Farm Vets prior to the bull going in.

6 month TB parish (no cases on the holding since purchasing farm in 2018).

FOREWORD - WR & KJ HARVEY

This major sale of the commercial herd of Hereford Cows and British Blue and Angus Heifers arises as a result of the Harvey Family deciding to reduce the cattle enterprise substantially at Weaver.

Hereford cattle have been kept at Weaver for nearly 20 years and the herd started with the purchase of two Pedigree Hereford Heifers from the Dovemount Herd. Numbers have been supplemented with the purchase of 21 British Blue Heifers and 13 Angus Heifers all of which are now calved and part of the suckler herd.

The Hereford cows are strong in frame and are ideally suited to the high hills at Weaver with cows grazing up to 1380 feet above sea level. The blue heifers were purchased from a Staffordshire Dairy Farm and have adapted well to their new environment and will continue to improve as they move forward to their new homes after the sale.

The sale comprises 65 cows and heifers and their steer and heifer calves that were born from 10th May 2025 onwards. The cows are running free of the bull and can go forward to fit prospective purchasers own systems at home.
