Among the tractors, the Valtra Valmet 8150 (S Reg) with just over 12,300 hours achieved £7,600. The mid-range Valtra T163 Direct (13 plate) with over 8,500 hours sold for £17,000. The most modern of the Valtras, a T174 Active (17 plate) showing just over 6,000 hours, reached a final price of £25,500.

Also drawing strong interest were the farm's pair of Kramer Allrad 1150 loaders, which had served as the main workhorses on-site. The older of the two, a 15 plate with just over 5,600 hours, achieved £17,000.
