FOREWORD/HERD DETAILS

This is a genuine dispersal of cattle on behalf of Hazlehurst Brothers who have farmed on the holding for approximately 25 years and with the approaching end of tenancy in 2027 the decision has been taken to disperse all the breeding cattle.

The cows receive no corn at all and winter rations are based on round baled silage with all beef calves usually kept on their dams for approximately 8 months and all progeny finished on the farming partnerships other unit at Hale.

Recent figures reveal that the feeding cattle have been growing at 1.25 kilograms daily lightweight gain on a TMR diet based on maize, silage together with other ingredients.

Virtually all the dams are blue or Limousin Crosses with a tiny proportion of Hereford and Sussex Cows in the sale.

All calves are homebred and BVD vaccinations have been undertaken.

The dams range from 2nd to 6th calvers.

All cattle were turned out in Mid April 2026.

All calves (excluding 3) have been born from Mid February 2026 onwards.

All cows run free of the bull. TB Jab date 12th May, 6 month TB Parish.

Several cows have calved to the previous stock bull which was a Pedigree Limousin.

The Black Continental Stock Bull was bred in Cumbria and is the progeny of a Pedigree Limousin Bull breeding on a Pedigree British Blue Heifer to produce this long and well-shaped Stock Bull born 10/04/2023.

All male calves have been castrated with virtually all the calves having been dehorned and one dam runs with twins.
